

Modals and conditional form

Modals are auxiliary verbs that ca be used with another verb to express a possibility, an opinion, to give advice, an obligation, to be polite or to promise something.

Fonction	Modal	Examples
Possibility	May, might	I may go to the party.
Capability	Can, could	I can stop smoking.
<u>Permission</u>	May, can	Mom, can I go out
		tonight?
Suggestion or advice	Should	You should not drink so
		much.
<u>Obligation</u>	Must, have to	You have to stop
		shopping so much.
Intention or promise	Will, would	I will try to stop.
<u>Politeness</u>	Would, could	Would you help me
		please?

Here are some examples on how to write an affirmative, a negative or a question sentence.

Affirmative	Negative	Question
I would go to the gym everyday.	I would not go to the gym everyday.	Would you go to the gym everyday?
I could stop smoking.	I could not stop smoking. (Couldn`t)	Could you stop smoking?
I should stop smoking		Shouldn't you stop smoking?
